


Hook: The Tin Forest

<u>English</u>

This week we are continuing our learning about instructions.

How to plant a seed Y1 - We will work together in a small group to write a set of instructions.

Y2 - We will write our own instructions using time conjunctions and imperative verbs.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we are developing our understanding of number.

Y1 - We will be looking at groups of objects/pictures and identifying how may there are.
Y2 - We will be learning how to partition numbers.

<u>Phonics</u>

The children have been split into four groups to match the next steps the children need. Y2 Mr Allen - Continuing to learn the alternative sounds. Y2 Miss McIntyre - Learning about split digraphs. Y1 Miss Allan - Introducing consonant clusters. Y1 - Miss McIntyre - reviewing consonant

<u>Theme</u>

In Geography we will be creating our own maps. We will be adding key features of human and physical geography to our maps, as well as creating our own keys.

In RE we will be exploring our big question,

How do Jews and Christians celebrate God as provider? This links with the Jewish festival of Sukkot and the Christian Harvest Festival.

In music we will be exploring music that is influenced by Africa.
