

# Hook: Forest Rangers

This week we will be starting a new enquiry focus called Forest Rangers. The children will become a team of expert rangers looking after all the good fairy tale characters in the forest.

# **English**

This week we are looking at The Three Little Pigs story.

Y1 - We will be looking at the start, middle and end of the story.

**Y2** - We will extend our learning by creating a new ending to the story.

## Maths

In maths we are learning about addition.

Y1 - We will be looking at adding one more to a given number and using the addition symbol to put it in a word sentence.

**Y2** - We will be focusing on adding two digit numbers.

### **Phonics**

The children have been split into four groups to match the next steps the children need.

Y2 Mr Allen - Continuing to learn the alternative sounds.

Y2 Miss McIntyre - Learning about split digraphs.

Y1 Miss Allan - Continuing to learn consonant clusters.

Y1 - Miss McIntyre - reviewing consonant clusters.

## Theme

In theme we will be using technology purposefully to manipulate and retrieve digital content.

In RE we will be exploring our big question,

How do Jews and Christians celebrate God as provider? This links with the Jewish festival of Sukkot and the Christian Harvest Festival.

In music we will be exploring music that is influenced South Africa. We will be playing musical games and activities.

#### PSHE and RSE

Soon we will be starting our PSHE and RSE lessons. Year 1 and 2 will be taught separately for these sessions over the coming weeks. Both year groups will be creating working agreements, i.e. rules to ensure everyone feels comfortable during these lessons. The children will also be introduced to the 'ask it baskets' and the roles these will have in the lessons.
