
KS1 Hook Sheet W/b: 25.11.19





We are a part of a team of royal correspondents commissioned by the King to investigate the fire. Where did it start? How did it spread? Why did it happen? Will it happen again?



English

We will continue writing our diary entries as part of our inquiry into the great fire of London. In year 1 we will be learning how to write extended using i.e. using and/because to join two sentences together. In year 2 we will continue to learn how to write in the present tense.

Maths

We will be exploring length and height. In year one we will be using mathematical terminology to compare the height and length of objects. In year 2 we will be looking at different units of measure (cm, m). We will be selecting appropriate units of measure to measure different objects. Both year groups will be solving practical problems involving measure.

Theme

In science we will continue to identify and compare the suitably of everyday materials for different uses. We will make simple predictions using scientific terminology and evaluate the materials effectiveness.

In RE we will be continuing to explore our big question, 'why is light an important symbol?'. We will continue to explore the story of Hanukkah, focusing particularly on how Hanukkah is celebrated. The children will learn about the dreidel and have a go at making their own.
