


Hook: Forest Rangers

This week we will be continuing our enquiry focus. The children will continue being a team of expert rangers looking after all the good fairy tale characters in the forest. However, there are still many different problems to help solve, including a noisy bridge causing a baby troll to wake up.



<u>English</u>

This week we are looking at character description within fairy tales.

Y1 - The children will be focusing on writing adjectives about a fairy tale character.

Y2 - The children will be writing a description about a fairy tale character.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we are learning about subtraction.

Y1 - We will be looking at taking away one more to a given number and using the subtraction symbol to put it in a word sentence.
Y2 - We will be focusing on

subtracting two digit numbers.

<u>Phonics</u>

The children have been split into four groups to match the next steps the children need.

Y2 Mr Allen - Looking at the 'ai' family. Y2 Miss McIntyre - Learning constant clusters

Y1 Miss Allan - Looking at phase 4 cluster sounds.

Y1 - Miss McIntyre - Learning about cluster sounds.

Theme

In theme we will be exploring different materials to see which is the best to help the billy goats cross the bridge quietly. In music we are continuing with the unit celebrating South African music. The children will be learning songs and singing rhymes. In R.E. we are continuing with this term's big question. As it is our Harvest Festival on Wednesday, we will be learning some of the ways that Christians celebrate and thank God for providing food.

PSHE and RSE

The children have started their PSHE and RSE lessons and are really enjoying them. The children will be introduced to the 'ask it baskets' and the roles these will have in the lessons.

Please could we ask for each child to bring in a baby photo of them. We will make photocopies and return originals. We will use these in our RSE lesson to form a discussion about growing up.
