### English

In English we will be learning about instructions. In year one we will practice speaking bossy sentences and have a go writing them in small groups. In year two we will begin to learn about verbs and how to use them in an instruction sentence.

### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will be exploring number. In year 1 we will be learning to write numbers up to 20 in numerals. In year 2 we will be learning how to identify the tens and units in a two-digit number, and how we can make these numbers using dienes.

## Phonics Assessments

Over the next week we will be completing phonics assessments and giving the children new reading books. If you have any questions about how to support your child's reading development at home, please speak to your child's teacher.

#### <u>Theme</u>

In geography we will be exploring maps. We will be creating our own maps making sure that we include human and physical features of geography. We will also be creating our own keys for our maps.

### PSHE and RSE

We will be starting our RSE and PSHE lessons over the next two weeks. Year 1 and 2 will be taught separately for these sessions over the coming weeks. Both year groups will be creating working agreements, i.e. rules to ensure everyone feels comfortable during the lesson. They will also be introduced to the ask it baskets and the roles these will have in the lessons.
