
KS1 Hook Sheet W/b: 14.10.19



Hook: Forest Rangers

This week we will be starting a new enquiry focus called Forest Rangers. The children will become a team of expert rangers looking after all the good fairy tale characters in the forest.

English

Y1 - We will be focusing on correctly writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Y2 - We will be looking at adjectives, nouns and verbs and using them in our writing.

Maths

Y1 - We will continue to learn about number bonds to 20. We be identifying number patterns and using what we know about number bonds to 10 to solve problems.
Y2 - We will be focusing on using our knowledge of subtraction facts to work systematically.

Phonics

The children have been split into four groups to match the next steps the children need.

Y2 Mr Allen - igh family.

Y2 Miss McIntyre - ou, ir, aw, oy and ed sounds.

Y1 Miss Allan - Reviewing consonant clusters.

Y1 - Miss McIntyre - le, wh, ph, ew and au sounds.

Theme

In design and technology, we will be building on what we have learnt about different materials in science to design a bridge. We will then go on to make a prototype bridge and evaluate them against a design specification.

In RE we will be learning about the Jewish Festival of Sukkot.

In music we will be learning about South African music. The children will be learning songs and singing rhymes.
