

School Council Meeting Holt Road site - Thursday 11th January 2018 Minutes

Joe from Community Sports Foundation came and told us about his job. Community Sports Foundation has just bought 22 acres - it used to be the Anglian Water social club. It is now called 'The Nest'. They want to build big sport facility. It is in two phases. Funds have already been raised for Phase 1 and builders have started work this month. Horsford Youth Football Club will be playing all home games there from September. There will also be a residential building with 80-bed bunk boxes. The former clubhouse is being rebuilt. All the above is Phase 1 and it is due to open on 31st May. July there will be a sponsored run there for Nebula schools. Distances can be chosen: 1km, 3km 5kms. Between now and December they need to raise more funds to build Phase 2. There will be a 3G football pitch which will be all weather, a sports hall, which will be 8 badminton courts in length. The sports hall is for any sport but mainly cricket and netball. There will also be a 60 station work gym, a cafe, a classroom and offices. Sport England has provided much of the money. Lots of glass.
