Collective Worship

Our value this half term is Truthfulness.

In Open the Book today we heard about a character from the Old Testament called Esther. She was a Jew and had been chosen by the king of Persia to be his queen. Esther had a kind uncle called Mordecai, who looked after her when her parents died. He warned her not to tell the king that she was a Jew.

The king's right hand man was Haman. He was horrible and commanded people to bow before him. Mordecai refused to bow and this made Haman furious. He went straight to the king to seek revenge. The king did not think and told Haman to kill all the Jews. When Mordecai heard this, he went to warn Esther. She asked the king to hold a party and wanted Haman to be there. The king agreed and Haman hoped that he would be able to kill Mordecai. When it was the day of the party, Esther told the king that there was someone who wanted to kill her. She told the king that it was Haman. Haman was confused as he didn't realise that Esther was a Jew. The king was angry with Haman and ordered him to be put to death.

One of the things we can learn from the story is that, just like Esther, it can be difficult to speak out about things that are wrong but we can often find the strength to do that.
