Collective Worship

Our value this half term is Koinonia (Fellowship)

In Open the Book today we heard the story from the Old Testament of God calling Samuel. It was night time and Samuel was in bed. He lived in the Temple. Eli was a priest in the Temple and during the night, Samuel heard someone calling his name. He assumed it was Eli so went running to Eli and said, 'Here I am.' Eli told Samuel that he hadn't called him and that he should go back to bed. A little later Samuel heard his name being called again and went to Eli but again Eli told Samuel that he hadn't called him and that he should go back to bed. A third time Samuel heard his name being called and went to Eli. Eli realised that it must be God calling Samuel and so told Samuel to say, 'Speak, Lord. Your servant is listening,' if he heard the voice again. Samuel did, indeed, hear his name being called again and so said, 'Speak Lord. Your servant is listening.' God gave Samuel messages for other people. One of the things that we can learn from the story is that it is important to listen to other people and to follow sensible advice.
