This week in Phonics...

New sounds - g, o, c, k.
Words of the week: into, he, she, we

This week in maths...

We are developing our understanding and representation of the number 5, counting out amounts from a larger group of objects and problem solving.

Play based learning opportunities...

- To write a list of items on the Wolf's shopping list.
- To use objects, dice and dominoes to show the number 4.
- To investigate different materials to see which would be best to build a house.
- To explore colour mixing to create pictures of the characters from the story.
- To act out the story using puppets or props.
- To go on a fairy tale hunt and make marks on the list of which ones you have seen.
- To play a giant fairy tale board game, taking turns to roll the dice and jump along the spaces.

Things to do at home...

- Share rhyming stories at home together, talking about the words that rhyme.
- Practise recognising the new sounds in your books at home together.
- Practise recognising the new words of the week.

Books to explore...

- The Three Little Pigs
- The Three Billy Goats Gruff
- Little Red Riding Hood
- Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- Hansel and Gretel

Theme words...

Once upon a time, fairy tale, pigs, wolf, brothers, goodies, baddies, house, huff, puff, builders, straw, sticks, bricks.
