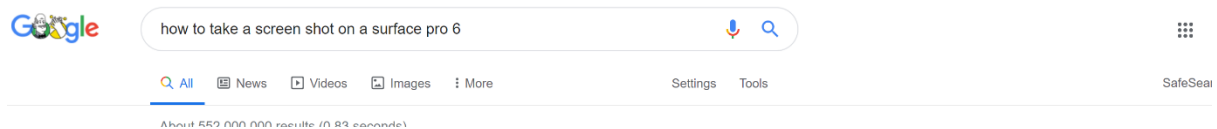


Dear parents/carers,

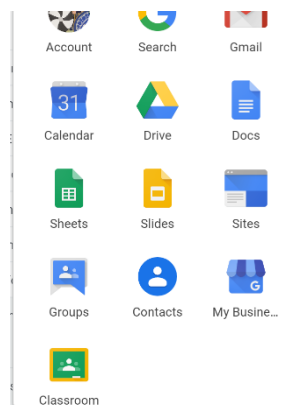

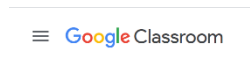

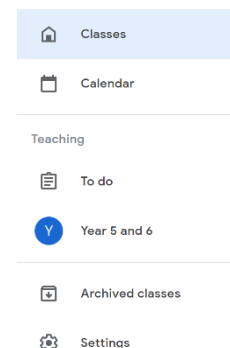
When this icon is pressed, a drop down will appear that looks similar to this –



When the Classroom icon is selected, your child will be directed to the Google Classroom. On the top left of the screen are three lines that look like this:



When they click on the lines a dropdown will appear like this:



Your child will now have access to tasks that their teachers have posted. If they are asked to enter a code, it is **6smehln**
