



## Theme: What's in the Wizard's Pocket?

### English:

#### Reception

Children to record a wizard's shopping list.

#### Year 1

Share and learn a poem. Practise with groups, record the poem for an audience and write the poem in their best handwriting.

### Maths:

#### Reception

They solve problems, using objects to support addition.

#### Year 1

Compare and describe capacity and volume (full, less, empty, half full, half empty). Measure and record capacity.

### Theme Learning:

Year 1 share and learn a poem. Book making, using card. Making a recording. Model how to share using technology in a purposeful way.

Reception will be making wizard's props, recording messages and labels for potions. Monitor decay and change over time, exploring objects and how they change, stay the same. Book making, using card.
