

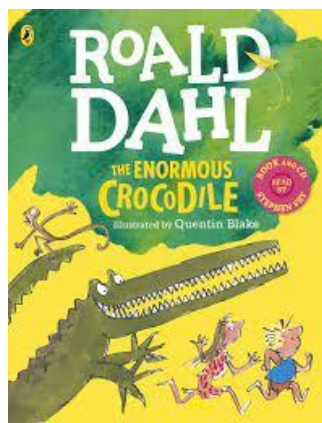
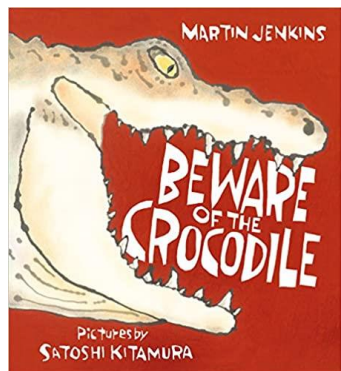
Beware of the Crocodile

We are learning to read 'I', 'the', 'is', 'as', 'a', 'no', 'go', 'of', 'to' and 'into'.

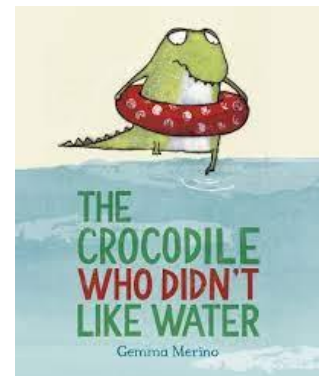
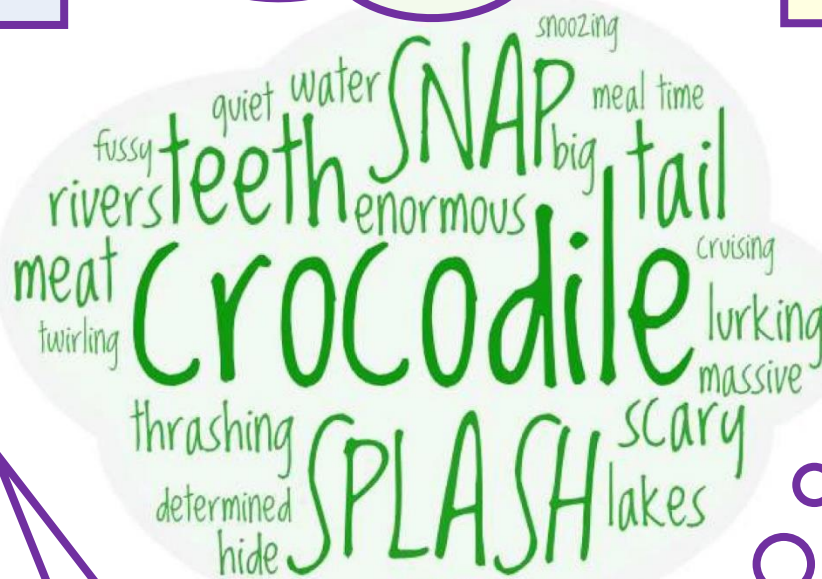


Why this 'theme'?
