We will be learning to read and write words containing the sounds 'ch', 'sh', 'th' and 'ng'.


We are learning to read 'are' and 'her', as well as continuing to practise all previously taught words.

Why this 'theme'?


We have chosen this theme as we are having a special visit from 'The Norfolk Institute' of Performing Arts' putting on the show 'Cinderella'.


