We will be learning to read and write words containing the trigraphs 'igh', 'ear', 'air' and 'ure'.


We are learning to read 'when' and 'out', as well as continuing to practise all previously taught words.

This week in maths...


We will be practising combining two groups of objects to find out how many there are altogether.

The first 'cups and balls' illusion was performed in Ancient Egypt in 2700BC.


