We will be learning the 'sounds' made by the letters h, b, f, ff, l, ll & ss.

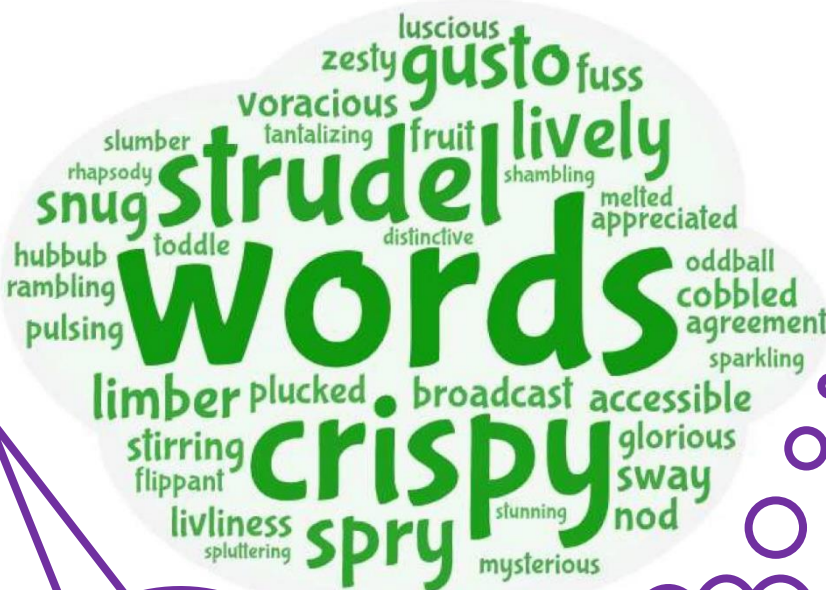
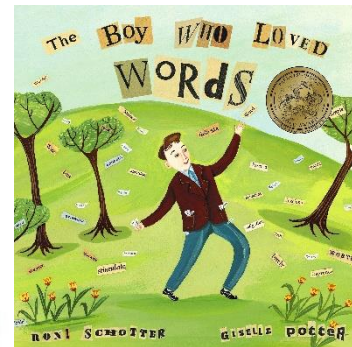
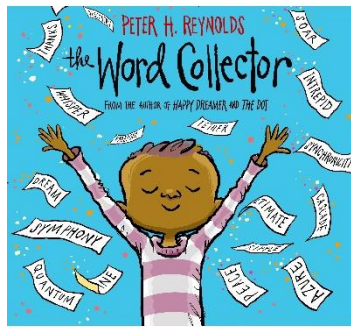
We are learning to read 'I', 'the', 'is', 'as', 'a', 'no', 'go', 'of', 'to', 'into', 'his' and 'put'.

We will be exploring repeating patterns, creating our own and spotting patterns in others.

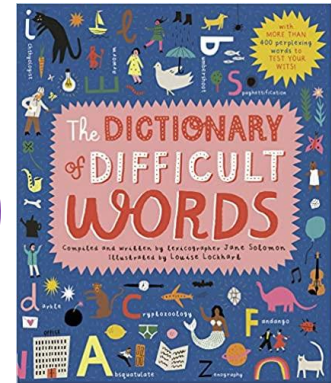
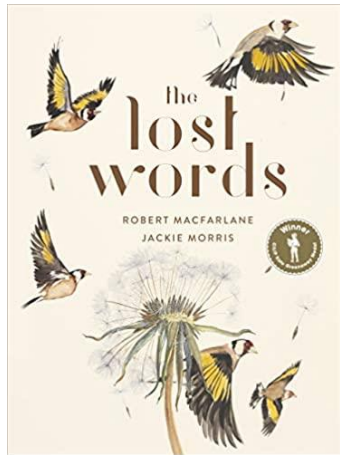


Did you know...
