We will be learning to read and write words containing all of the sounds we have learnt so far.

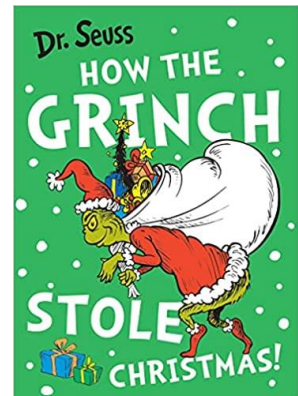
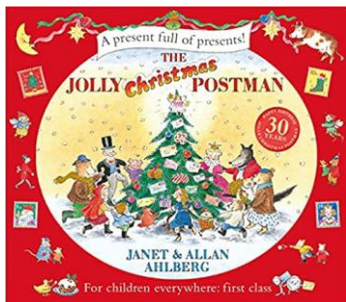
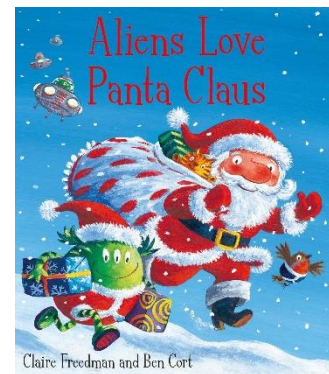
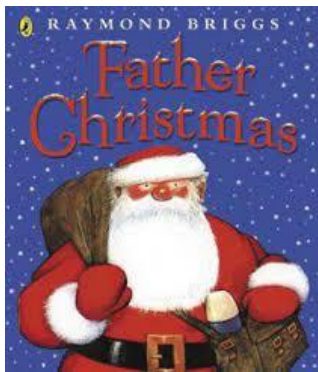
We are learning to read all previously taught words.
