We will be exploring counting, developing listening skills and learning how to work together to solve jigsaw puzzles.

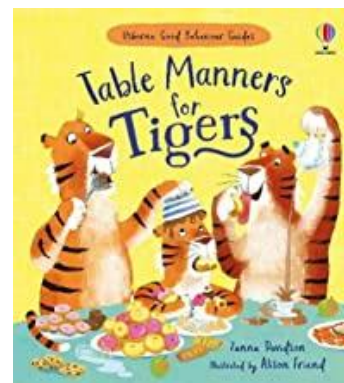
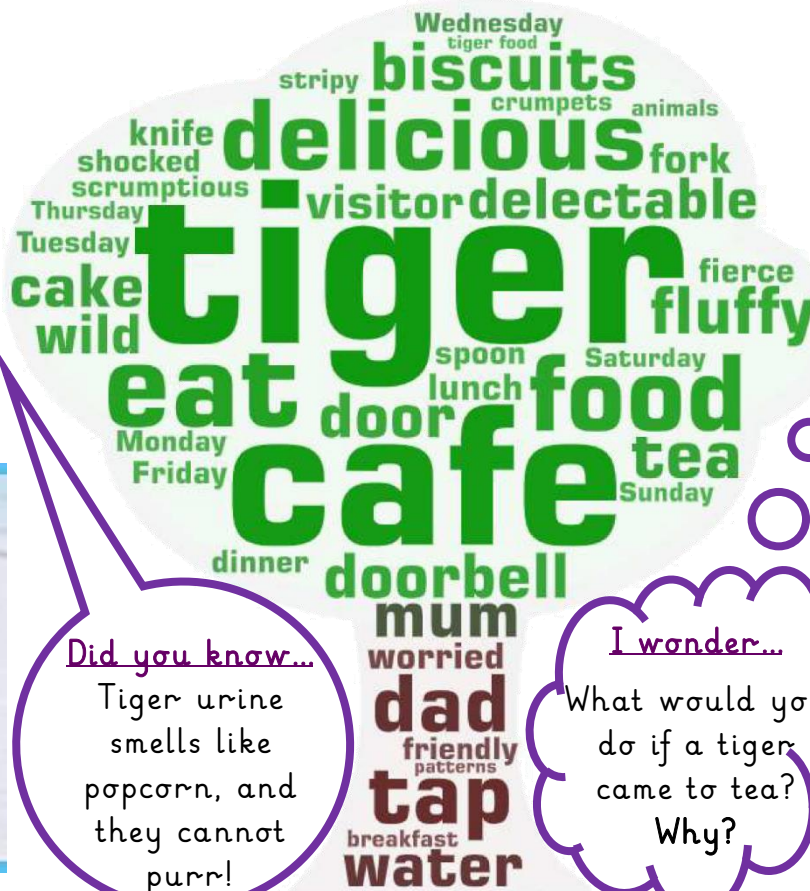
Why this 'theme'?
