We are learning to read 'I', 'the', 'is', 'as', 'a' and 'no'.

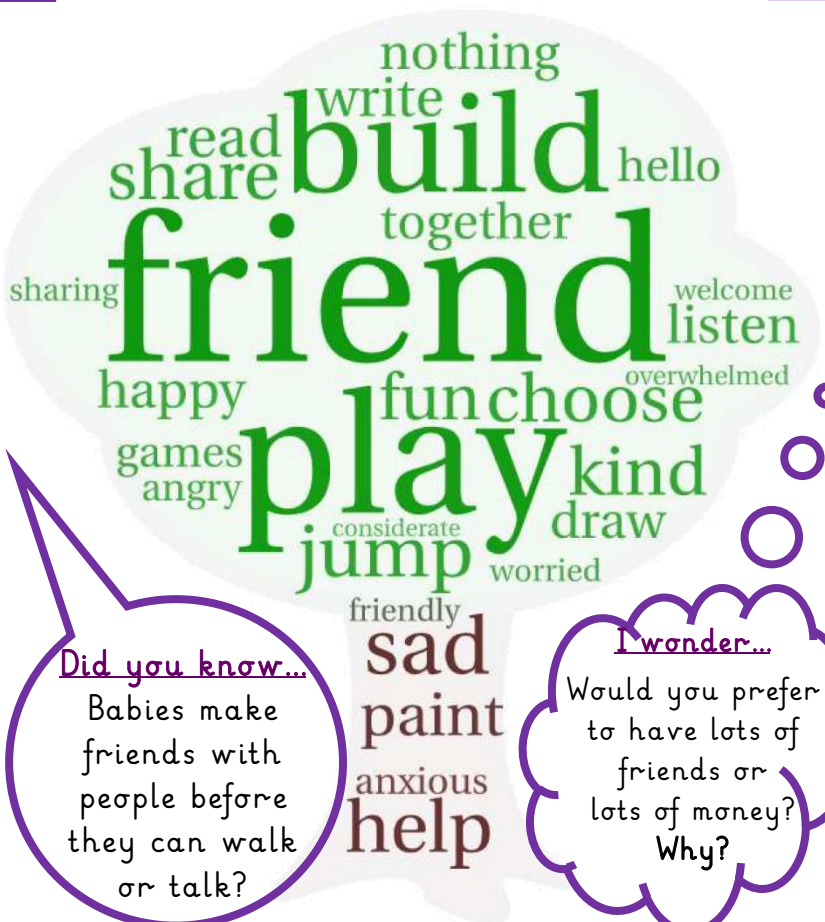
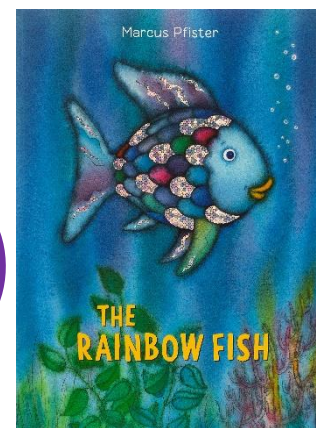
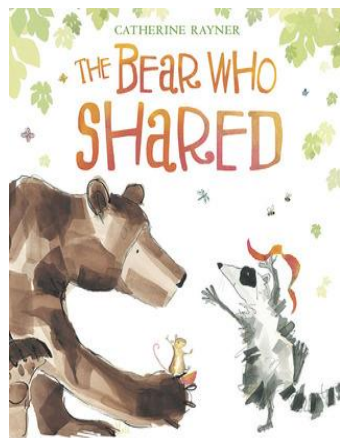
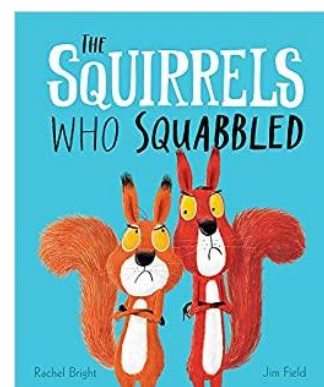
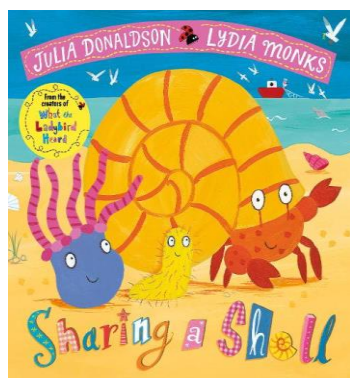
Why this 'theme'?
