Impact of Physical Education Grant Spending 2015-2016

- Employment of a PE specialist HLTA ensures children have planned progression throughout KS2 in all areas of the PE curriculum. Children who have previously not engaged in sport feel supported by the HLTA throughout their time at the school and have increased participation.
- Extra-curricular clubs offered at no cost to pupils developing skills, knowledge, understanding and confidence. These pupils are also able to act as role models to other pupils during curriculum lessons, developing their confidence and self-esteem whist raising standards through demonstration.
- Increased access to high quality curriculum P.E. through the employment of P.E. specialist teachers at KS1 who work with school staff to upskill and develop professionally.
- Participation in competition has increased, within the Sports Partnership, the Nebula Partnership and beyond. Pupils have taken part in SSP cross country, tag-rugby, sports hall athletics and adapted games. These events have used SSF for transport and supply cover.
- Pupils also compete in football and cross country leagues. Subscriptions are payable to league associations.
