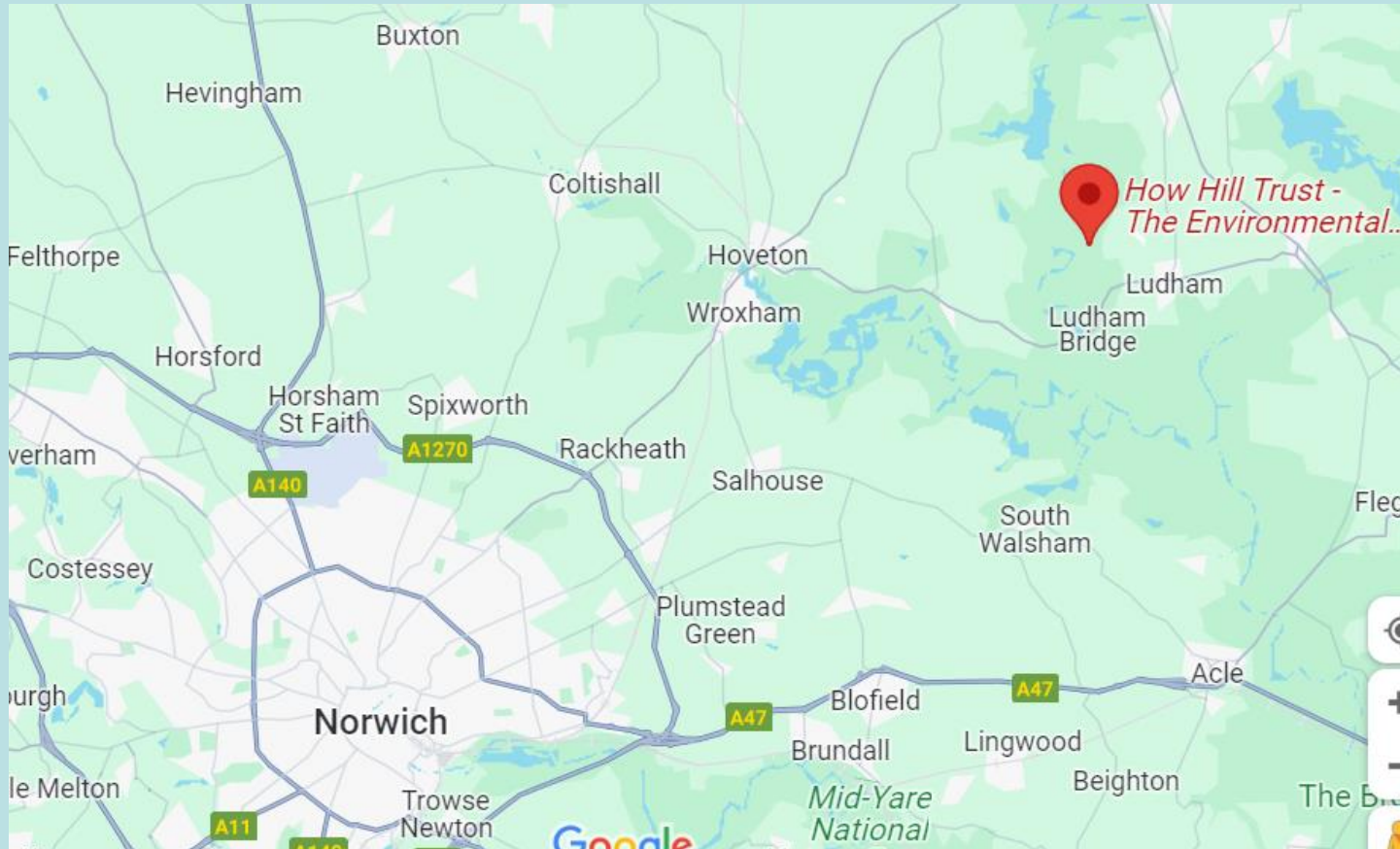

Prices
