English

In KS1 we will be learning about instructions. We will be looking at instruction examples, exploring the different features and language used. In year one we will be looking at information sentences, and in year two we will be exploring how to use time connectives.

Maths

In Year 1 we will be exploring addition. We will learn all about '+' and '=' symbols, and how to read addition number sentences. We will then be solving problems using objects and a number line to help us.
In Year 2 we will be learning all about subtraction. We will be using our knowledge of place value to 'explode' our numbers to solve subtraction problems.
