



Theme: Maths week

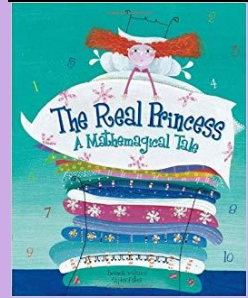
English

In KS1 we will be writing our very own non-fiction information texts about the royal family. In year 1 we will be practicing asking and answering questions about the royal family. We will use the questions as headings in our information text. In year 2 we will be using the conjunctions but, when, because, or, if, and to help us write information sentences to include in our information texts.

Maths

In Year 1 we will be exploring capacity. We will be using the vocabulary full, half full and empty to make comparisons. In Stickman class year 2 will be solving missing number problems. We will be using the inverse and drawing our own number lines. In Zog class year 2 will be constructing and interpreting pictograms. We will be asking and answering questions based on the information gathered from the pictograms.
