## <u>English</u>

In Year 1 we will be exploring stories with similar settings. We will have a go at writing our own story setting descriptions, making sure we make our writing exciting.

In Year 2 we will be exploring the different features of a non-chronological report. We will be taking this opportunity to further practice using and applying conjunctions and punctuation correctly.

### <u>Maths</u>

In Year 1 we will practice recognising the value of coins. We will go to the school shop and practice our coin recognition skills by paying for items.

In Year 2 we will be exploring how to 'balance' number sentence problems. We will use our problem solving skills to help use balance number sentences. We will also be comparing 3D and 2D shapes, using the correct mathematical terminology to discuss similarities and differences.

#### Theme

In Art we will continue to explore the works of LS Lowry. We will look at his painting techniques and how he uses different colours to create shade and tone.
