Hook:

We have heard whispers of mysterious noises coming from the island. We have been commissioned as part of the team of explorers on behalf of the Queen to explore the island and discover the source of the mysterious noises.



In Year 1 we will become philosophers. We will be asking questions about a variety of interesting pictures; and discussing our thoughts and feelings towards these pictures. We will then practice extending our answers with 'because'. In Year 2 we will be taking part in a variety of activities that support our spelling and writing skills. We will be playing games and working in groups to become super spellers and writers.

<u>Theme</u>

In science we will continue with our experiments, including thinking about the different parts of an experiment. For example, observations, fair tests and conclusions. We will continue to test a variety of materials to check if our initial predictions were correct.

<u>Maths</u>

In Year 1 we will be solving place value problems. We will become number detectives to practice identifying numbers to 100. We will also be playing place value games.

In Year 2 we will be playing maths games that help to develop our understanding of the place value and number. We will work in small groups to create our own maths board games using our knowledge of place value and number.

Next week the year 2s will be completing their end of key stage assessments. The children have worked very hard throughout the year and should be very proud of themselves and all that they have achieved. We will be completing the challenges in our classrooms as usual.
