



Theme: Where the wild things are.

English

In year 1 we will be exploring the structure of stories, including the character, setting and plots. We will practice changing one part of the story structure, for one of our very own ideas.

Maths

In year 1 we will be exploring fractions. We will look at finding halves and quarters, and practice identifying written fractions $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$.

In year 2 we will become problem solvers. We will be solving problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and money.

Phonics

We will be completing our end of term phonics assessment this week. We will be reviewing key sounds and reading tricky words.

In RE we will begin to explore our new big question, 'how does celebration bring a community together?'. We will read stories and take part in drama based activities.

In ICT we will be introduced to coding. We will learn basic coding skills and practice using these when exploring programs such as scratch.
