



Theme: Reading Week

During reading week we will be exploring a variety of texts that celebrate black history month. We will be exploring a range of themes including celebrating uniqueness and difference.

English

In KS1 we will be engaging in lots of different writing tasks as part of our reading week inquiry. Year 1 will be creating an information poster, focusing on writing the perfect sentence. Year 2 will be writing letters, thinking about audience and different letter features.

Maths

In Year 1 we will be learning all about position and direction. We will be playing games and taking part in practical activities.
In Year 2 we will be exploring fractions of shape. We will be finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of different shapes. We will also be solving fraction based problems.

Phonics

We will be completing phonics assessments and reading with the children individually to ensure they are on the correct colour reading band. Please keep reading with your child over the holidays.
