



Theme: Mission Space!

We are going to be taking on many different roles as part of our space topic. We will be a part of the mission control team, take part in astronaut training and explore what it is like to travel to space.

English

In KS1 we will be planning and writing our own space stories. In year one we will be making sure we use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our sentences. In year two we will be focusing on developing the setting in our story.

Maths

In Year 1 we will be learning about time. We will be learning to tell the time to o'clock and half past the hour.

In Year 2 we will be learning how to read scales. We will be reading scales that go up in steps of 2, 5 and 10. We will also be estimating where numbers may go on the scale.
