

# Theme: Animal Park

## English

In Year 1 we will be exploring the alphabet. We will be learning the different letter names and matching capital letters to lowercase letters. In Year 2 we will become authors and write the words to the story 'Journey'. We will be using adjectives and learning how to build tension within a story.

#### Maths

In Year 1 we will be learning about odd and even numbers. We will be singing songs and playing games to help us recall odd and even numbers. In Year 2 we will continue to explore time. We will be learning how to tell the time to quarter past and quarter to the hour. As an extra challenge we will practice telling time to the nearest 5 minutes.
