



Theme: Mission Space!

We are going to be taking on many different roles as part of our space topic. We will be a part of the mission control team, take part in astronaut training and explore what it is like to travel to space.

English

In KS1 we will be starting our non-fiction unit. We will be working towards writing our own information book about why you might want to be an astronaut. During English lessons we will be exploring a variety of different writing opportunities to help us towards writing our information books.

Maths

In Year 1 we will be learning the days of the week and months of the year. We will be singing songs to help us remember the order!
In Year 2 we will be learning how to solve multiplication problems. We will be using objects and learning how to draw arrays to help us solve these problems. We will be focusing on the 2s, 5s and 10s times tables.

Phonics

All the children will be revising key sounds and spellings in their phonics groups.

Theme

In History we will be learning about significant people who have contributed to space travel, including Buzz Aldrin and Neil Armstrong.
In Music we will be exploring sound including playing instruments.
