School Results

We are really pleased to let you know that our school has made significant improvements in reading, writing and maths as judged by the end of Key Stage 2 SAT tests taken by our pupils in May 2016. It is only this term that data has been published so that we can see how we have performed against similar sized schools in our local area, as well as nationally. So as soon as we found out we wanted to share it with you! These tests were the first ones taken following the new National Curriculum and were deemed significantly harder than those taken in previous years, which were marked using levels.
