Mill Lane

Please can we remind you that the children need to pay for their meals each day. If your child forgets their money we will issue them with a payment slip so the amount can be repaid to school.

Welcome Back!

Hello and welcome back to the start of another school year. If your child has just started with us in Reception, or any of our other year groups, we hope you and your child have settled into the routines of life at Horsford CE VA Primary School. For those of you that have returned, we hope it hasn't been too much of a shock to the system getting back into the habits of the school run!

Thank you for preparing your child for the term. The children all look lovely and smart and are generally arriving at school on time. On that note, please can we remind you that the school day starts at 8.55am on both sites. Children are allowed into the buildings from 8.45am to allow time for you to drop children at both sites if you need to. Please can we ask you to make sure that you ring school before 9am each day that your child is ill. We will have to make contact with you if we do not know why your child is absent from school.

Mill Lane Car Park System

For those of you new to our Mill Lane site we thought we would outline how the car park works to ensure it runs as safely as possible. We operate a one way system, with cars entering from the first gate as you approach from Holt Road. Please park in the marked bays first (you may also use the gravel car park at the far end of the car park) and then use the left hand parking lane. Please do not leave too much space between the cars so enough visitors can fit in. If you enter the car park and find all the spaces full please continue through on the right hand driving lane and find a space out on Mill Lane rather than waiting and blocking the entrance gate. There are double yellow lines just inside the gate for this reason. By doing this cars then queue back up Mill Lane and block the pedestrian crossing making it dangerous for children to cross. Please trust us when we say that the car park does empty relatively quickly so if you do park in a bay and get blocked in by someone in the parking lane you won't be there for long. Having said that please be considerate to others and if you need to speak to a member of staff try not to park in the parking lane as this will block others in who want to leave straight away. Finally please do not drive in through the out gate (even if you are trying to park in the disabled bays) as this could cause an accident.

Thank you for all of your patience and consideration when using our car park; it is a luxury that many schools do not have. It would be a shame for us to close it off because it has become too dangerous for us to use.
