### Norwich Foodbank

We have received a thank you email from the Norwich Foodbank in response to our donations towards their Reverse Advent Calendar. In total we donated 297kg of food, so thank you for your support. The food bank were delighted with the response to this campaign and overall donations totalled 3,529kg. Based on the average weight of the food boxes they supply, this would be enough food to feed 470 local people, who are in crisis, for 3 days each.
