#### Year 5 cycle training - adult helpers needed

Some of our year 5 children will be completing their Level 2 cycle training on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February. Part of this course involves them cycling on the road – they will use Mill Lane and part of Angela Road. In order to help the instructor carry out the course she requires two adult helpers to ensure the children are kept safe when cycling on the road. We still need one adult for the Thursday afternoon and two for all day on the Friday. This is such an important skill for the children to learn, particularly as they become more independent and start cycling to school on their own.
