Our new theme for Collective Worship this half term is Forgiveness. Reverend Margaret visited us during the first week of this term to introduce the value to the children through an assembly on both sites. We are looking forward to exploring this theme throughout the next few weeks.



Today the children heard the story from 2 Kings 5 verses 1-27. This tells of a commander of the army called Naaman. He had a skin disease called leprosy and wanted to be healed. A servant girl told his wife that he should try to see the prophet Elisha. Namaan went to see him but it was a messenger who told him what to do. The messenger said that Namaan should wash in the river Jordan seven times. Namaan was not happy that Elisha had sent a messenger to him and was even more cross that he had to wash in the river. Eventually he was persuaded to do this and after the seventh wash, he had been healed.

This story teaches us to have confidence that often advice given to us should be followed.
