## Planned Expenditure for 2017-18

This year we have agreed to spend £4798 on renovating the line markings on the playgrounds at both sites. This is something which will have an instant impact on all of the children, allowing them to have more enjoyment during their free time. It will also enhance both playground areas significantly. We finalised the quotes during our October meeting so are now awaiting a proposed date for the work to be carried out. We will keep you posted!

As usual we hope to be able to add another £1000 to the minibus fund this year. Through the Nebula Partnership we were lucky enough to buy a new minibus using the accumulated funds from the previous Junior School's PTA funds, but this of course depleted the account. The minibus is an essential resource for the school as it is used to take groups of children to numerous events throughout the year, including allowing our school council to meet up on one site once a fortnight. Our older minibus has seen better days and so we are trying to build back up the funds which will allow us to replace it when the time comes.

We also agreed at our last meeting to pay for this year's site licence for Mill Lane's Accelerated Reader programme. Parents on the committee, who have children at Mill Lane, agreed that it was a valuable resource which had seen their children embrace a love of reading through the online quizzes and points system.

We have also just started looking into getting quotes for new wooden play equipment to replace the pirate ship at Holt Road. Again we will keep you posted here!
