- Create your own seaside board game, write the numbers in each space, add your own pictures and use two dice to play it together.
- Play the I spy and add challenge, counting up the objects and adding them together to find the total amount.
- Welcome to the ice cream shop! Count up the different coins to find the total and record the number, practising your number formation.
