#### Writing Challenge Ideas...

- Watch or share a jungle story and write about your favourite part with your own illustration. Can you use the word 'because' in your sentence?
- Draw a picture or build your own jungle animal using junk modelling or construction materials. Use your sound mat to write a sentence or two to describe it.
- Watch videos about zoos, identifying different animals.
   Make a list of your favourite animals, using a sound mat to help you.
- Look at the powerpoint 'What am I?' and listen to the clues to see if you can work out what animals they are describing. Choose an animal picture and write a clue on the back.
- Share jungle animal facts. Write it down your favourite fact using the sound mat to help you.

## Maths Challenge Ideas...

- Play the game 'I spy and count'. Count up how many there are of each animal and write down the number.
- Watch DJ Neave's number rap and practise writing numbers to 20.
- Create your own jungle board game, write the numbers in each space, add your own pictures and use two dice to play it together.
- Play number bingo. Roll two dice, add them together and record the number on the bingo.
   Repeat six times before playing BINGO!
- Dice scoring game- roll two dice and add the amounts together, recording your scores. Who can score the most/ least?
