Writing Challenge Ideas...

- Watch or share a farmyard story and write about your favourite part with your own illustration.
- If you were making a farm, which animals would you have? Use your sound mat to help you write a list!
- Do an observational drawing of a farm animal from a walk or from a picture and label it.
- Make your own farm information book. Draw pictures and add a sentence under each to caption them.
- Listen to your family telling you some animal jokes and create your own farmyard joke page to send into the 'School Link' magazine.

Maths Challenge Ideas...

- Challenge your family to a game of bingo! Choose the grid size and write a different number in each box. Eyes down, look in!
- Have 'duck walk' competition (squat down and flap your wings as you waddle!) and measure who can go the furthest.
- Create your own farmyard boardgame, write the numbers in each space, add your own pictures and use two dice to play it together.
- 'Bunny Hop Challenge' take it in turns to use a stopwatch (most mobile phones have one) to see how many seconds it takes to do 20 bunny hops. Who was the fastest? Who was the slowest?
- Find the answers to the farmyard addition challenges by counting up or counting on.
