#### Writing Challenge Ideas...

- Watch or share 'We're going on a bear hunt', 'The Everywhere Bear' or another bear story. Write about your favourite part with your own illustration. Can you use the word 'because' in your sentence?
- Draw a picture of your favourite bear and use your sound mat to write a sentence or two to tell us all about it.
- Make a list of your favourite bears (e.g. Winnie the Pooh, Paddington, Everywhere Bear) and add illustrations for each.
- Watch bear videos and share bear facts. Write down your favourite bear fact using a sound mat to help you.
- Write down the tricky words on the bear picture-how many can you write down?

#### Maths Challenge Ideas...

- Complete the teddy bear dot-to-dot picture, ordering numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Count out the food at the teddy bears picnic and write the number to record how many food items there are.
   Check out DJ Neave's number rap to help with your number formation.
- Create your own Bear board game, write the numbers in each space, add your own pictures and use two dice to play it together.
- I spy and count- count up the amount of each story characters, writing down how many there are. Check out DJ Neave's number rap to support number formation.
- Goldilocks and the three bears snakes and ladders, rolling two dice, adding the spots to find the total and jumping that amount of spaces.
