Writing Challenge Ideas...

- Watch or share a pirate story together. Write about your favourite part with your own illustration. Can you use the word 'because' in your sentence?
- Create your own treasure map, drawing pictures, adding labels and an x marks the spot.
- Practise writing the tricky words on the treasure map pictures, remembering to start your letters in the right place.
- Create a pirate wanted poster, drawing a picture and adding a sentence to describe the pirate.
- Check out the pirate jokes in the link, and create your own pirate joke page to give us all a hearty chuckle!

Maths Challenge Ideas...

- Complete the pirate dot-to-dot picture, ordering numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Find the answers to the adding and taking away questions and colour the parts of the picture the corresponding colour. Can you work out what the picture is?
- Create your own pirate board game, write the numbers in each space, add your own pictures and use two dice to play it together.
- Practise your number formation to 20, tracing the numbers on the pirate paper, using DJ Neave's number rap to help you.
- Play I spy and add, counting up the amounts of each pirate object before adding amounts to find the total.
