Date: WB: 4.6.18

Investigate

Plant different seeds in Jack's garden and watch them grow.
Record what you can see each day.

Books

The tiny seed, The enormous turnip, Jasper's Beanstalk, Titch, All about plants, How things grow, Jim and the beanstalk.

Make

Create a collage beanstalk, flower or hen.

Create coin rubbings.

Make giant coins using shiny materials.

Make a musical instrument to send the giant to sleep.

Maths

The children will be solving adding and taking problems by counting on and back.

Develop skills reading cvcc/ccvc/cvcc words including those with digraphs.

Mr Neave's phonic group

Recap digraphs and practise blending cvcc/ccvc words.

At Home

Practise recognising all of the tricky words we have been learning.

Talk about what a seed needs to grow and take care of your seed over the holiday.

Look at the plants and flowers in your garden- draw your favourite one and write a sentence about why you like it.
