We will be learning to read and write words/ sentences containing blends, digraphs and trigraphs.


We are learning to read all the previously taught tricky words, as well as learning how to spell 'some', 'come' and 'little'.


# Why this 'theme'?


We have chosen this theme as some of the children have been particularly interested in space and the Planets. This also ties in with our special 'Space' themed lunch on Thursday.


#### This week in maths...

We will be exploring taking away using the ten frames, number tracks and objects.










#### <u>Did you know.</u>
