We will be learning to read and write words/ sentences containing blends, digraphs and trigraphs.


We are learning to read all the previously taught tricky words, as well as learning how to spell 'said', 'so' and 'do'.





We have chosen this theme to build upon the children's interest around holidays, visits to the seaside and building dens.


This week in maths...

We will be exploring adding, using objects on ten frames and number tracks.










Did you know.
