Year 3/4 Gressenhall Farm & Workhouse Trip - Friday 6th March 2020

Dear Parents/Carers,

Next term, the children in Year 3/4 will be learning all about life in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. As part of this exciting topic, the children will be going on a trip to Gressenhall Farm & Workhouse to learn about life in Neolithic Britain.

Your child will attend the trip on **Friday 6th March 2020**. On the day of the trip, the children will arrive at school at the usual time and **wear non-school uniform**, as some of the activities may be messy. We will leave for Gressenhall at 9:00am. The children will return to school before 3:20pm and can be collected as normal.

The children will need to bring a **packed lunch** and a **drink** for the day. If your child has a **free school meal**, this will be provided by the school. Please note that there will be no time on the trip to go to a gift shop, therefore, the children will not need any money on the day.

Much of the day will be spent outside, completing a variety of activities. Gressenhall recommends that participants wear several layers to keep warm when the weather is cold. They also suggest that hats, gloves, waterproof trousers and a coat are worn. Lastly, your child will need to bring a plastic bag containing wellies, labelled with their name, to be worn when carrying out activities on the field. Children will need to wear their trainers on the coach. Please be aware that all children will need to bring a **rucksack/bag** which will contain their belongings, lunch and drink for the day.

Should your child require travel sickness medication, please ensure that they have this before coming to school. If your child requires further medication for the return journey, please place it in a sealed envelope and label it with your child's name and the time that the medication should be taken. If your child needs an inhaler, please make sure that they bring it in a named bag.

We have records of your child's medical needs but please inform us of any recent changes.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10 for this trip. This will contribute to the cost of entry plus travel to and from Gressenhall. Many thanks in advance for your help with this. Please note, that the trip will only go ahead if we receive sufficient contributions.
