


### Year Two Hook Sheet W/B 13.3.17

Once you can spell these words use them to write sentences (remember the four sentence types we have learnt).

Can you collect and bring into school natural materials e.g. bark, small stones and moss as we will be building minibeast hotels in the next few week.

# This week's Philosophy Question:
