This week we are doing a creative literacy lesson around the story of "Leaf Man".

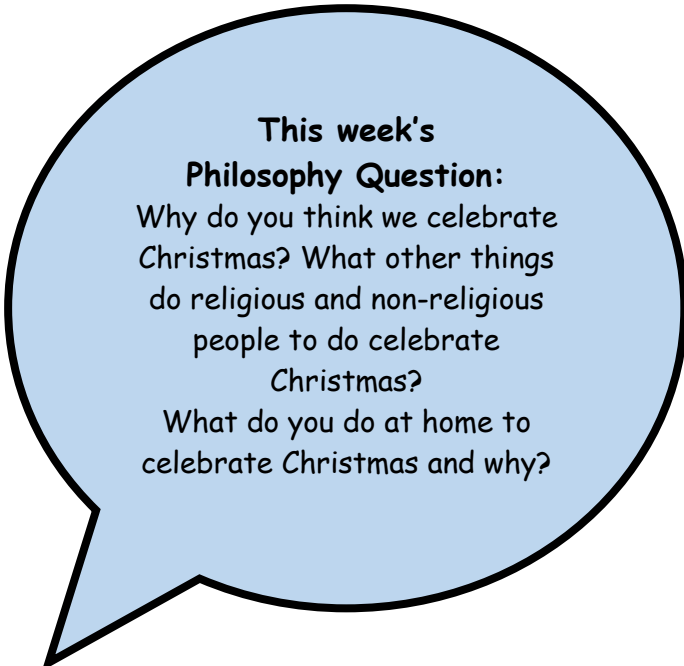
The rest of the week will be focused on learning about religions.
