Communication and language: Because.

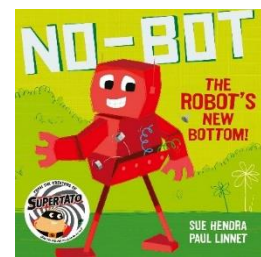
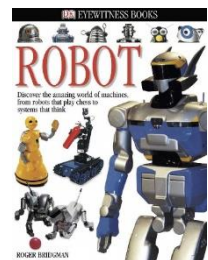
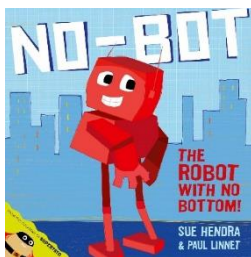
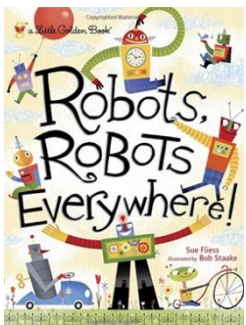
