We will be developing our understanding of number by finding, subitising and representing numbers 1, 2, 3.

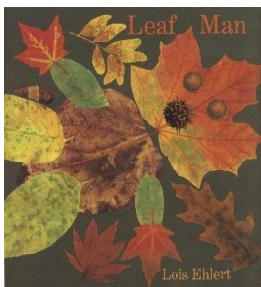
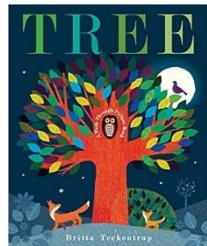
Skills Focus

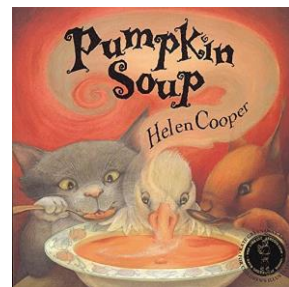
Did you know...
