 We are learning to read 'I', 'the', 'is' and 'as'.

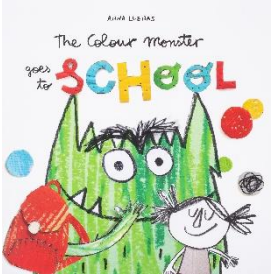
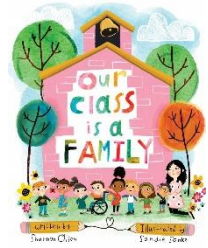
Why this 'theme'?

 Managing self - we will be learning about the school rules and why it is important to follow these.

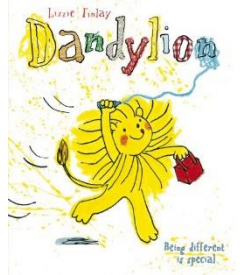
